1 On 10-8-2011, I was on patrol in a marked Sheriff¿s Office vehicle in 2 full uniform in the Town of Los Altos Hills. At approximately 1100 3 hours County Communications told us a Sheriff¿s Deputy had been 4 involved in a shooting incident at Park Avenue and Sunol Street in 5 San Jose. County Communication described the suspect, later 6 identified as Suspect 01 Omar Muhdi, as a white male adult, 5¿7¿ 7 approximately 140-150 pounds and wearing a blue and grey striped 8 shirt and jeans. I drove to the area to assist and County 9 Communications said the suspect was last seen in the ivy in the area 10 of Bird Avenue and Park Avenue. I arrived on the scene approximately 11 0 minutes later and joined several Deputies and San Jose Police 12 Officers on the southwest corner of Montgomery Street and Park 13 Avenue. I was told S01 Muhdi was possibly in the San Jose Fire 14 Department training facility at 255 South Montgomery Street. 15

16 At approximately 1133 hours, once a sufficient perimeter was setup, 17 both Sheriff¿s Deputies and San Jose Police Officers began a search 18 of the San Jose Fire training facility. The fire training facility 19 was partially fenced in and consisted of a garage to house the fire 20 engines and several outlying buildings. We began our search on the 21 east side of the property and moved west. We first searched and 22 cleared the garage which housed the fire engines. Once we cleared 23 that building we began to move further west. Behind that building 24 was an alleyway between a smaller portable classroom building on the 25 north and a larger building to the south.

27 San Jose Police Officer Ryan Kimber #3612, Deputy Bugarin #2088 and 28 myself began to search the alleyway. As we moved west, there was a 29 series of lockers. Deputy Bugarin and I were searching the lockers 30 and at the end of the series of lockers was a rectangular storage

1 container. The storage container was longer than tall and the lid 2 opened at the top. At approximately 1149 hours, Deputy Bugarin 3 opened the storage container lid and I could see what looked like a 4 grey and blue striped piece of clothing. Deputy Bugarin told us the 5 suspect was inside, stepped away from the storage container and the 6 lid to the container closed.

8 Officer Kimber, Deputy Bugarin and I pointed our firearms at the 9 storage container and ordered SO1 Muhdi to show us both his hands. 10 Based on the original call I had responded to of a Sheriff¿s Deputy 11 firing shots after SO1 Muhdi was seen in a stolen vehicle and had 12 reached for his waist area as if reaching for a weapon, I believed 13 SO1 Muhdi was armed and dangerous and likely had a deadly weapon in 14 his possession. SO1 Muhdi stuck one hand out of the lid of the 15 storage container but would not show us his second hand. The lid was 16 only opened only enough to see SO1 Muhdi¿s hand and I could not see 17 inside the rest of the storage container. After approximately 10-20 18 seconds of ordering SO1 Muhdi to show us both his hands, SO1 Muhdi 19 finally stuck both hands from the lid.

20

I re-holstered my firearm and grabbed SO1 Muhdi¿s left arm with both hands and either Deputy Bugarin or a San Jose Police Officer grabbed SO1 Muhdi¿s other arm and we pulled him from the storage container onto the ground face down. SO1 Muhdi continued to violently resist our attempts to arrest him by thrashing his arms and legs and trying to pull away from our grasp. In an attempt to control SO1 Muhdi further, I placed my right knee on SO1 Muhdi¿s back and held his left hand behind his back. I removed my handcuffs and began to handcuff SO1 Muhdi¿s left hand while deputies and officers struggled to control SO1 Muhdi¿s right hand. After I handcuffed SO1 Muhdi¿s left

1 hand, I looked to my right and saw S01 Muhdi had somehow placed his 2 right hand underneath his body near his front waist area. This was 3 the same area where SO1 Muhdi was seen to be possibly reaching for a 4 deadly weapon and I believed S01 Muhdi was likely trying to gain 5 control of some kind of deadly weapon. In an attempt to gain control 6 of S01 Muhdi;s right arm, Deputy Bugarin and an unknown San Jose 7 Police Officer placed their knees on S01 Muhdi; s upper back area. We 8 gained control of S01 Muhdiis right hand and as I was trying to 9 handcuff the right hand, S01 Muhdi continued to thrash around with 10 his body and pulled his left arm back under his body and under his 11 front waist area. I used both hands to remove SO1 Muhdi¿s left hand 12 from underneath his body and was finally able to handcuff both of S01 13 Muhdi¿s hands behind his back at approximately 1150 hours.

14

15 SO1 Muhdi complained of pain to his left arm as well as to his head 16 and neck area after the arrest. S01 Muhdi had small amount of blood 17 on his face from a head or facial wound he received during the arrest 18 while resisting. The area where SO1 Muhdi was lying face down was 19 partially dirt with many small rocks. EMS and San Jose Fire 20 responded to the scene to give SO1 Muhdi medical attention and SO1 21 Muhdi was eventually transported to Valley Medical Center(VMC) for 22 further treatment. Custody of S01 Muhdi was turned over to the San 23 Jose Police Department and Officer Kimber followed S01 Muhdi to 24 VMC.

1 PD Sqt Johst #3237 and I were holding our position when I heard 2 several voices yelling loudly near the north side of the brick and 3 mortar building. Sqt Johst and I turned around and ran towards the 4 yelling. As I ran around the corner I saw Deputies, Tuttle, Bugarin, 5 and Rangel, pointing their firearms at a small plastic storage 6 container. 3 On 10/08/2011 at approximately 1104 hours, I responded to the area of 4 San Carlos Street and Dupont Street to assist Deputy Rodriguez #2026, 5 to look for a suspect (S01 Omar Muhdi) that had fled from a stolen 6 vehicle.

8 As I responded to the scene, I heard Deputy Rodriguez say over the 9 radio that he had fired two rounds at SO1 Muhdi. I also heard Deputy 10 Rodriguez yell several times over the radio, ¿Get on the ground, you 11 better get on the ground¿. I arrived on scene and took a position 12 at the top of the San Carlos Street overpass, overlooking Dupont 13 Street and the neighboring businesses. Deputy Rodriguez said that 14 SO1 Muhdi had jumped fences of the neighboring businesses and was 15 seen running towards San Carlos Street from Park Avenue.

17 A few minutes later, County Communication advised units involved in 18 the search that S01 Muhdi had been seen running Eastbound on Park 19 Avenue, in between Park Ave and Bird Avenue.
