16 laser scanner operator, and am the current CSI Unit supervisor.

19 received a call from S/O Investigations Division Captain D. Rodriguez									
20 #1659 advising me that SVDPS was requesting S/O personnel to respond									
21 to Sunnyvale and conduct 3D laser scans at									
22 the scene of a fatal Officer Involved Shooting incident which was									
23 also associated to a murder investigation at the same location. CSI									
24 K. Mah #2055, also a trained LEICA ScanStation C10 3D laser scanner									
25 operator, was my assigned partner.
