151 handcuffs, I want you to spread your feet first, okay? What I want you to do is  
152 keep your hands way back until I tell you not to, all right?  
153  
154 A: Yes. (Unintelligible) over there?  
155  
156 Man1: Yeah, (unintelligible).  
157  
158 Q: Yeah.  
159  
160 Man1: Cool.  
161  
162 Q: We should high risk right now.  
163  
164 Man1: Okay. Nothing inside the pockets, man?  
165  
166 A: No.  
167  
168 Q: No. Hands at the back of your head. All right. Turn around, have a seat. That  
169 chair right there, okay? So (unintelligible) all about this or try to keep your  
170 hands on the table, okay? This one is cool (unintelligible).  
171  
172 Q1: Yeah.  
173  
174 Man1: (Unintelligible) and then we're like really specific on face, (unintelligible)  
175 and, um, obviously ones on the shoulders. (Unintelligible)

177 Q: Right, so anything is important all of the (unintelligible).

179 Man1: (Unintelligible) yeah with a little scale.

181 Q: Yeah. And the first one with no scale.

183 Man1: First, first attempt.

185 Q: Yeah.

187 Man1: Just front, back and head and with the, this, this (unintelligible).

189 Q: (Unintelligible).

191 Man1: No. I don't want to deal with all the clothing after all of this, (unintelligible)  
192 outside (unintelligible).

194 Q: Let me see if I can (unintelligible) for me.  
195  
196 Man1: So you ready?  
197  
198 Q: Yes, one second (unintelligible). Hey, you have the (unintelligible).  
199  
200 Man1: Yeah.  
201  
202 Q: Okay.

204 Man1: Don't be shy. (Unintelligible).  
205  
206 Man2: Okay.  
207  
208 Man1: 50, 50 plus.  
209  
210 Man2: Okay, thanks.

212 Q: Sounds good.

214 Man2: (Unintelligible).

216 Man1: Yeah, you saw (unintelligible).

235 the wall, face me and keep your hands on your side, okay? Left. Face str-,  
236 straight ahead. I want you to face right here, man, away from me.

238 Man1: Just put your head (unintelligible).  
239  
240 Q: Keep facing that way. The other way. Face the other way. Face me again. Let  
241 me see your hands. Turn them up. Okay (unintelligible). Move your hands out  
242 a little bit so I can get the picture. Right there, yeah, fine.  
243  
244 Man2: (Unintelligible).  
245  
246 A: That way?  
247  
248 Q: Yeah. Turn with me, face that way. Face to the other side of me please. Turn  
249 to your right. Okay. (Unintelligible) please? Thanks. Now turn to your right.  
250 Okay. Can you turn that way please? Okay (unintelligible) one more time for  
251 me? Okay. Uh, (unintelligible) again. Uh, like this. Okay. Turn slowly for me  
252 (unintelligible). Cool. Face (unintelligible) one time. Okay, so wait for me  
253 (unintelligible)? No, all the way. Yeah. Keep - keep turning. Right there. Stop.  
254 Push your neck down a bit. (Unintelligible) we're good.  
255  
256 A: (Unintelligible).  
257  
258 Man1: Yeah. (Unintelligible), okay?  
259  
260 Q: He's hot. He's hot, by the way.  
261  
262 Man1: (Unintelligible). Um...  
263  
264 Q: Got it.  
265  
266 Man1: Got it.  
267  
268 Q: Cool.  
269  
270 Man1: Uh, I didn't (unintelligible) that's fine?

271  
272 Q1: That's fine. Ask him to go ahead and...  
273  
274 Man1: (Unintelligible).  
275  
276 Q1: ...ask him to, uh - ask him to pull up his sleeves.  
277  
278 Man1: And shorts? Okay.  
279  
280 Q: Pull up the shorts.  
281  
282 Man1: No, I'll do that.  
283  
284 Q: And then, uh - and you got the back view to it?  
285  
286 Man1: Yeah. I had 360s and...  
287  
288 Q: Cool.  
289  
290 Man1:...so then I'll just (unintelligible) other one.  
291  
292 Man2: (Unintelligible).  
293  
294 Q: We'll (unintelligible)  
295  
296 Man2: Okay. All right.  
297  
298 Q: Okay. Have you stand one more time.  
299  
300 A: Hmm?  
301  
302 Q: Stand one more time. You - (unintelligible) right now, okay? We'll have you  
303 pull your sleeves up, please? (Unintelligible) yeah. Okay. Turn that way now.  
304 Okay. Next, pull up your shorts for me. Shorts. Pull them both up. Yes. Cool.  
305 Is that blood or are those like (unintelligible)?  
306  
307 A: (Unintelligible)  
308  
309 Q: Where the scabs from?  
310  
311 A: Um, from heroin.  
312  
313 Q: Oh, yeah, yeah, yeah. (Unintelligible). Turn around, the same thing. Just do  
314 like that. Cool. We'll have a (unintelligible) one time, hands on the table and  
315 we'll give you some water. Yup. Put your hands like this. Okay. So now we'll

316 have him strip down?  
317  
318 Man1: Not yet. (Unintelligible) in there.  
319  
320 Q: About 50 or 60? (Unintelligible) have it?  
321  
322 Man1: Yeah.  
323  
324 Man2: (Unintelligible) I'll have you take off each items only one at a time, all right?  
325 And you try to (unintelligible) on this bag, okay? So just go slow, take it off  
326 and put each one at the bag, all right? When you do that, I want you to stand  
327 on that thing and stay on there the whole time, okay? Yeah, 13077-0391.  
328 (Unintelligible) on that paper. We're gonna (unintelligible). Uh, face me then,  
329 look at me. Scoot back a little bit. There you go. Good. Turn to the right.  
330 (Unintelligible). Face away from me. All right, keep turning. Okay.  
331 (Unintelligible) next.  
332  
333 Q: (Unintelligible).  
334  
335 Man2: Turn again, this time facing me. All right, quarter turn. Face away from me.  
336 One more time. (Unintelligible) write you up first.  
337  
338 Q: (Unintelligible).  
339  
340 Man1: (Unintelligible)  
341  
342 Q: (Unintelligible)  
343  
344 Man1: Anything?  
345  
346 A: (Unintelligible).  
347  
348 Q: (Unintelligible) just pull off the shorts and, uh, um, put them in these.  
349  
350 Man1: Okay. So let's take off those. Socks will come up here.  
351  
352 Q: (Unintelligible),  
353  
354 Man1: Take your socks right there on the white tape for me.  
355  
356 Q: (Unintelligible)  
357  
358 A: (Unintelligible)  
359  
360 Q: Yeah.

362 A: Today?  
363  
364 Q: (Unintelligible).  
365  
366 Man1: (Unintelligible) by it.  
367  
368 Q: Is that - is that a wound down your leg or no?

370 A: I don't know. Yeah.

384 A: Yeah. (Unintelligible) in there.

386 Man1: Well (unintelligible) right there.  
387  
388 Q: You want something?  
389  
390 A: Yeah, please.  
391  
392 Q: Some water?  
393  
394 A: Yeah.  
395  
396 Q: Okay. Um, (unintelligible) clean yourself up like washing your hands,  
397 washing your face, you wanna do that?  
398  
399 A: Um, yeah. Like (unintelligible).  
400  
401 Q: Okay. You (unintelligible)?  
402  
403 A: Yeah.  
404  
405 Q: Okay. Let me get you some water and then we'll, uh - we'll, uh, get you all set

406 up. It's locked. Okay. Go ahead and, uh - keep it going, actually.  
407  
408 A: Okay.  
409  
410 Q: Yeah. All right. Let's go. Just those and then we'll (unintelligible).  
411  
412 Man1: (Unintelligible)  
413  
414 Q: Uh, no. Not yet. (Unintelligible), okay?  
415  
416 Man1: We're gonna take that shirt (unintelligible)  
417  
418 Q: Okay? (Unintelligible), okay?  
419  
420 Man1: Yeah, yeah - no. No, one or two? Two?  
421  
422 A: I'm sorry, I thought you're asking me if I - how many cups of water I want.  
423  
424 Man1: You want two?  
425  
426 A: If I can, please? I just (unintelligible)  
427  
428 Q: (Unintelligible)  
429  
430 A: Yeah.  
431  
432 Q1: (Unintelligible) go ahead and end the investigation.

434 Q: This is Deputy Tolbertson, Badge 2155 ending case 13-077-0391 at 2110  
435 hours.
