HATE Synopsis: **On 8-16-15, Sunnyvale Police had an officer involved shooting in their jurisdiction that left one person dead. The Sheriff's Office was requested to assist with the scene diagram. Sheriff's Office personnel responded and used the Leica C10 scanner to document the crime scene. The data was later transferred from the scanner to a computer software program. Two copies of the finished data were copied on DVDs and were given to Sunnyvale Police. One DVD containing the data was booked into evidence at Sheriff's Office HQ.**

<p>1 DETAILS:</p> <p>2</p> <p>3 On 8-16-15, at approximately 1857 hours, I was off duty when I</p> <p>4 received a call from Lt. Rivera who is assigned to our Investigation</p> <p>5 Division. Lt. Rivera informed me Sunnyvale Department of Public</p> <p>6 Safety had an officer involved shooting in Sunnyvale. Sunnyvale</p> <p>7 Department of Public Safety requested the use of the Sheriff's Office</p> <p>8 scanner to document the crime scene. Lt. Rivera asked if I was</p> <p>9 available to respond. I informed Lt. Rivera I was available and would</p> <p>10 respond to the call. Lt. Rivera advised me Sgt. Leon #1685 would also</p> <p>11 be responding.</p> <p>12</p> <p>13 I met with Sgt. Leon at Sheriff's Office Headquarters. We loaded the</p> <p>14 Leica C10 scanner and the rest of the gear we needed. Sgt. Leon was</p> <p>15 told we needed to respond to the command post.</p> <p>16</p> <p>17 We arrived on scene at 2035 hours. We met with Sunnyvale Lt. Kim who</p> <p>18 briefed us on how the incident occurred. Lt. Kim walked us through</p> <p>19 the crime scene. The crime scene included the rear parking lot of</p> <p>20 Motel 6, located at 806 W. Ahwanee Avenue. The Motel 6 rear parking</p> <p>21 lot had an entrance off of San Aleso Avenue. The scene also included</p> <p>22 part of San Aleso Avenue, and three additional properties located on</p> <p>23 the east side of San Aleso Avenue.</p> <p>24</p> <p>25 Lt. Kim said the Suspect's (S-01)body was still in the rear parking</p> <p>26 lot of 814 San Aleso Avenue. I was not informed of the Suspect's name</p> <p>27 so he will be referred to in this report as the Suspect-1. <p>1 For the purpose of this report San Aleso Avenue runs north and south.</p> <p>2 The crime scene involved a total of four parking lots. The parking</p> <p>3 lots were located on both sides of the street. The first parking lot</p> <p>4 was the Motel 6 rear parking lot. The second parking lot was located</p> <p>5 to the south and east of a large commercial building with the address</p> <p>6 showing as 750-756 San Aleso Avenue. The third parking lot was</p> <p>7 located to the east of a large commercial building located at 769-766</p> <p>8 San Aleso Avenue. The fourth parking lot was located east of a large</p> <p>9 commercial building located at 814 San Aleso Avenue.</p> <p>10</p> <p>11 Sgt. Leon and I decided to start the first scan next to the Suspect's</p> <p>12 body. When we did the walk through a large white pop-up style canopy</p> <p>13 was covering the Suspect's body. Sgt. Leon, Lt. Kim, and I moved the</p> <p>14 canopy away from the Suspect's body so that it would not show up in</p> <p>15 the scan.</p> <p>16</p> <p>17 I was the operator for the scanner for all the station moves. The</p> <p>18 crime scene was dark and Sunnyvale did not provide additional</p> <p>19 lighting. We ran the scanner without photography due to the low light</p> <p>20 conditions.</p> <p>21</p> <p>22 At approximately 2120 hours, we began scan #1. The first scan captured</p> <p>23 the rear parking lot of 814 San Aleso Avenue. The scanner was placed</p> <p>24 north of the Suspect's body. We placed the twin target pole in the</p> <p>25 parking lot before the start of the scan. The twin target pole was</p> <p>26 introduced as a way to verify the measuring capabilities of the</p> <p>27 scanner. After the scanner completed the scan we did a high</p> <p>28 resolution scan around the Suspect's body and evidence placards.</p> <p>29</p> <p>30 Scan #2 was also in the same parking lot as scan #1. 5 Scan #3 was positioned on a dirt island that divided the properties
6 between 814 San Aleso Avenue and 760 San Aleso Avenue. We placed the
7 scanner on top of a downed fence that was knocked down by the SWAT
8 vehicle.

10 Scan #4 was positioned in the parking lot located on the north side of
11 760-766 San Aleso Avenue. After the scanner completed the scan we did
12 a high resolution scan around two Sunnyvale marked patrol vehicles
13 and evidence placards.

14
15 Scan #5 was positioned near the front left fender of the patrol
16 vehicle with license plate .

17
18 Scan #6 was positioned between the two involved patrol vehicles. After
19 the scanner completed the scan we did a high resolution scan around
20 evidence placard #14.

21
22 Scan #7 through #11 were positioned in the parking lots east of the
23 large commercial buildings located at 760-766 San Aleso, and 750-756
24 San Aleso. We did additional high resolution scans around evidence
25 placards #6, #7, #8, and #9.

26
27 Scan #12 through #14 were positioned in the parking lot south of the
28 large commercial building located at 750-756 San Aleso. We did
29 additional high resolution scans around evidence placards #1, #2, #3,
30 #4, #5, and #28.

6 Scan #16 through #20 were positioned in the Motel 6 parking lot. We								
7 finished the last scan at 0140 hours.								
8								
9 Sgt. Leon and I put all of our equipment away and departed the scene								
10 at approximately 0155 hours. Sunnyvale Department of Public Safety								
11 told me their case number was 15-5821.								
12								
13 On 8-17-15, I did the computer work and stitched all the scenes								
14 together to make one large 3D diagram. I later used the 3D diagram								
15 and created TruViews. TruViews allows users to view the scan on								
16 computers that do not have the Cyclone software that is needed to								
17 view the 3D digram. I transferred the TruViews to DVD's.

21 On 8-20-15, I booked one copy of the DVD into evidence at Sheriff's								
22 Office Headquarters. I made two additional copies for Sunnyvale								
23 Department of Public Safety.
