20	the screaming began W-01 Rivera ran into the changing room area. W-05
21	Burden secured the inmate scheduled to be released to a chair. W-05
22	Burden then went to the corner in front of the changeup room and
23	asked if they needed any help. W-05 Burden continued to hear loud
24	noises and believed there was a scuffle. W-05 Burden wasn;t sure if
25	the inmate inside was naked and didn;t want to go in until he was
26	sure. Based on the sounds he was hearing, he didn;t believe O-01
27	Broussard or W-01 Rivera were in danger.
28	
29	W-05 Burden went and got waist chains and shackles ready and waited
30	outside the changing room. W-05 Burden never saw inside. W-05 Burden
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1	began hearing O-01 Broussard saying, "Calm down sweetie" and other
	"mother" like things. W-05 Burden described O-01 Broussard tone as
3	that of a mother talking to a 2-year-old.

5	After a few minutes, O-01 Broussard, W-01 Rivera came out with O-02
6	and W-05 Burden assisted them in putting restraints on O-02
7	W-05 Burden also saw W-03 Simpson-Hogan come out of the
8	changing room, which surprised him because he had no idea W-03
