Synopsis: **On 11-12-15, Sunnyvale Police had an officer involved shooting in their jurisdiction that left one person dead. The Sheriff's Office was requested to assist with the scene diagram. Sheriff's Office personnel responded and used the Leica C10 scanner to document the crime scene. The data was later transferred from the scanner to a computer software program. Two copies of the finished data were copied on DVDs and were given to Sunnyvale Police. One DVD containing the data was booked into evidence at Sheriff's Office HQ.**

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1 **DETAILS:**

3 On 11-12-15, at approximately 1328 hours, I was on duty when I
 4 received a phone call from Captain Rodriguez who is assigned to our
 5 Investigation Division. Captain Rodriguez informed me Sunnyvale
 6 Department of Public Safety had an officer involved shooting in
 7 Sunnyvale. Sunnyvale Department of Public Safety requested the use of
 8 the Sheriff's Office scanner to document the crime scene. Captain
 9 Rodriguez asked if I was available to respond. I informed Captain
 10 Rodriguez I was available and would respond to the call. Captain
 11 Rodriguez advised me Sgt. Cortez #1887 would also be responding.

12

13 I met with Sgt. Cortez at Sheriff's Office Headquarters. We loaded the
 14 Leica C10 scanner and the rest of the gear we needed. Sgt. Cortez
 15 made contact with Sunnyvale DPS and they informed him to respond to

18 We arrived on scene at 1420 hours. We met with Sunnyvale Lt. Kim who
 19 briefed us on how the incident occurred. Sunnyvale Officer Smart
 20 #12974 walked us through the crime scene. The crime scene involved a
 21 ground level 2 bedroom apartment a patio area leading
 22 towards the apartment's front door, and a grassy area in front of the
 23 patio area.

24

25 We began scanning the exterior of the building at 1445 hours. We
 26 placed the twin target pole in the street before the start of the
 27 scan. The twin target pole was introduced as a way to verify the
 28 measuring capabilities of the scanner at the start of electronic
 29 mapping. We also placed two 6-inch round targets on top of the patio
 30 fence. The 6-inch targets were added to the scene so that we could

1 connect the interior of the scene with the rest of the scene outside.
2 The targets were only used for scan station 1, 2, and 3. We removed
3 the targets after scan station 3. The following is the list of scan
4 stations:

6 SW-1 Exterior shot with the scanner placed on the sidewalk west of the
7 crime scene.
8
9 SW-2 Exterior shot with the scanner placed on the sidewalk in front of
10 the patio walkway leading towards the lower apartments.
11
12 SW-3 Interior shot of the apartment with the scanner placed in the
13 doorway area.
14
15 SW-4 Exterior shot with the scanner placed on the sidewalk east of the
16 crime scene.
17
18 SW-5 Exterior shot of the crime scene with the scanner placed in the
19 walkway leading to the patio area.
20
21 SW-6 Exterior shot of the crime scene with the scanner placed at the
22 entrance of the patio next to the apartment front door.
23
24 SW-7 Interior shot of the crime scene with the scanner placed in the
25 living room. The scanner was moved to the kitchen and we scanned the
26 kitchen using the same scan world. We realized we used two different
27 locations with one scan world. We re-scanned the living room at a
28 later time and labeled it SW-9. We also re-scanned the kitchen and
29 labelled it SW-10. We will not be using SW-7 because it scanned two
30 different locations under the same name.

2 SW-8 Interior shot of the crime scene with the scanner placed in

3 between the hallway leading to the two bedrooms.

4

5 SW-9 Interior shot of the crime scene with the scanner placed in the

6 living room.

7

8 SW-10 Interior shot of the crime scene with the scanner placed in the

9 kitchen.

10

11 SW-11Interior shot of the crime scene with the scanner placed in the

12 bathroom.

13

14 SW-12 Interior shot of the crime scene with the scanner placed in the

15 bedroom located in the east side of the apartment.

16

17 SW-13 Interior shot of the crime scene with the scanner placed in the

18 bedroom located in the west side of the apartment. We placed the twin

19 target pole inside the bedroom before the start of the scan. The twin

20 target pole was introduced as a way to verify the measuring

21 capabilities of the scanner at the end of electronic mapping.

22

23 We were going to scan the complete exterior of the apartment complex

24 that surrounds the involved apartment. It was dark by the time we

25 finished SW-13. We decided to come back the following day to finish

26 scanning the exterior of the apartment.

27

28 We picked up all of our gear and departed the scene at 2005 hours.

29

30 On 11-13-15, at approximately 1210 hours, I drove to the apartment

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1 complex to finish scanning the exterior. I completed four additional
 2 scans which were as follows:
 3
 4 SW-14 Exterior shot of the apartment complex with the scanner placed
 5 on the sidewalk east of apartment #4.
 6
 7 SW-15 Exterior shot of the apartment complex with the scanner placed
 8 on the walkway northeast of apartment #4. This scan station captured
 9 the back side of the involved apartment.
 10
 11 SW-16 Exterior shot of the apartment complex with the scanner placed
 12 on the walkway directly behind apartment #4. This scan station
 13 captured the back side of the involved apartment.
 14
 15 SW-17 Exterior shot of the apartment complex with the scanner placed
 16 on the walkway northwest of apartment #4. This scan station captured
 17 the back side of the involved apartment.
 18
 19 I completed the last scan at 1320 hours.
 20
 21 I later connected all the scan stations to make one large 3D diagram.
 22 I then used the 3D digram and created TruViews. TruViews allows the
 23 data to be seen on computers that do not have the Cyclone software
 24 that is needed to view the 3D diagram.
 25
 26 On 12-22-15, I transferred the scan file containing the TruViews to a
 27 USB that was prvided by Officer Smart. On 12-23-15, I handed the USB
 28 containing the TruViews to Officer Smart.
