20	back of both of his legs in an attempt to get him to bend his legs so
21	that I could gain control.

23	At this time, I heard S01 Simmons yell ¿Fuck you.¿ I then saw S01
24	Simmons right hand curled underneath him, so I decided to gain
25	control of his right arm, fearing he may try to push himself off the

19	Once I was able to gain full control of S01 Simmons; right arm using
20	the wrist twist lock, I maintained control of his arm and no longer
21	felt his resistance. I immediately placed it on the small of his
22	back. Assisting deputies responded and were able to assist in
23	securing S01 Simmons; arms with handcuffs. I was relieved by
24	assisting deputies once S01 Simmons was restrained.
