4 At approximately 1344 hours, I arrived at the above location. I met 5 with Sgt. Marquez and Deputy Harvey who told me SO1 Jorge drove 6 recklessly, led deputies on a high speed pursuit, false imprisoned 7 the passenger of the vehicle, and resisted arrest after multiple 8 commands were giving to him. The passenger of the vehicle, later 9 identified as (VO1) , immediately jumped out of the vehicle, 10 was complaint and obeyed the commands from deputies. VO1 was 11 emotionally distraught and deputies had a hard time trying to calm 12 her down to get a complete statement about the incident. VO1 13 was able to tell deputies that SO1 Jorge was on drugs and she wanted 14 him to stop the vehicle prior to the patrol car getting behind them. 15

16

17 K9 Raider and I placed ourselves approximately half of a car length 18 behind SO1 Jorge;s vehicle. Based on the nature of the offenses SO1 19 Jorge committed; vehicular pursuit, false imprisonment, actively 20 resisting deputy;s commands and the fact that he was unsearched and 21 concealed himself within a vehicle, I believe that there was 22 potential for danger to the deputies on scene if K9 raider had not 23 been utilized.

24

25 Based on my training and experience, individuals who are under the 26 influence and display this level of resistance may attempt to flee on 27 foot or fight law enforcement personnel to avoid arrest. Based on 28 all the facts stated, I determined the use of my K9 partner Raider 29 was within Policy.

12 After Sergeant Jones removed Raider from the vehicle, deputies pulled 13 SO1 Bustos out of the vehicle through the front, passenger door. I 14 assisted other deputies to bring SO1 Bustos up from the creek bank 15 onto a flat ground. I grabbed and held SO1 Bustos;s right shoulder 16 and dragged him to a flat ground.

18 S01 Busto was bleeding from his face and head. Deputy Hickenbotham 19 and Deputy Vega rendered first aid by covering S01 Bustos; wounds 20 with dressing while applying pressure. I knelt down by S01 Bustos; 21 feet and held his ankles with each of my hands to prevent him from 22 kicking other deputies.

23

24 Paramedics arrived on scene and rendered first aid on SO1 Bustos. SO1 25 Bustos was placed on a gurney and transported to Valley Medical 26 Center via Medic 60.

27

28 I conducted vehicle inventory search prior to the tow. I did not 29 locate any contraband or any high value items inside the vehicle. 30
