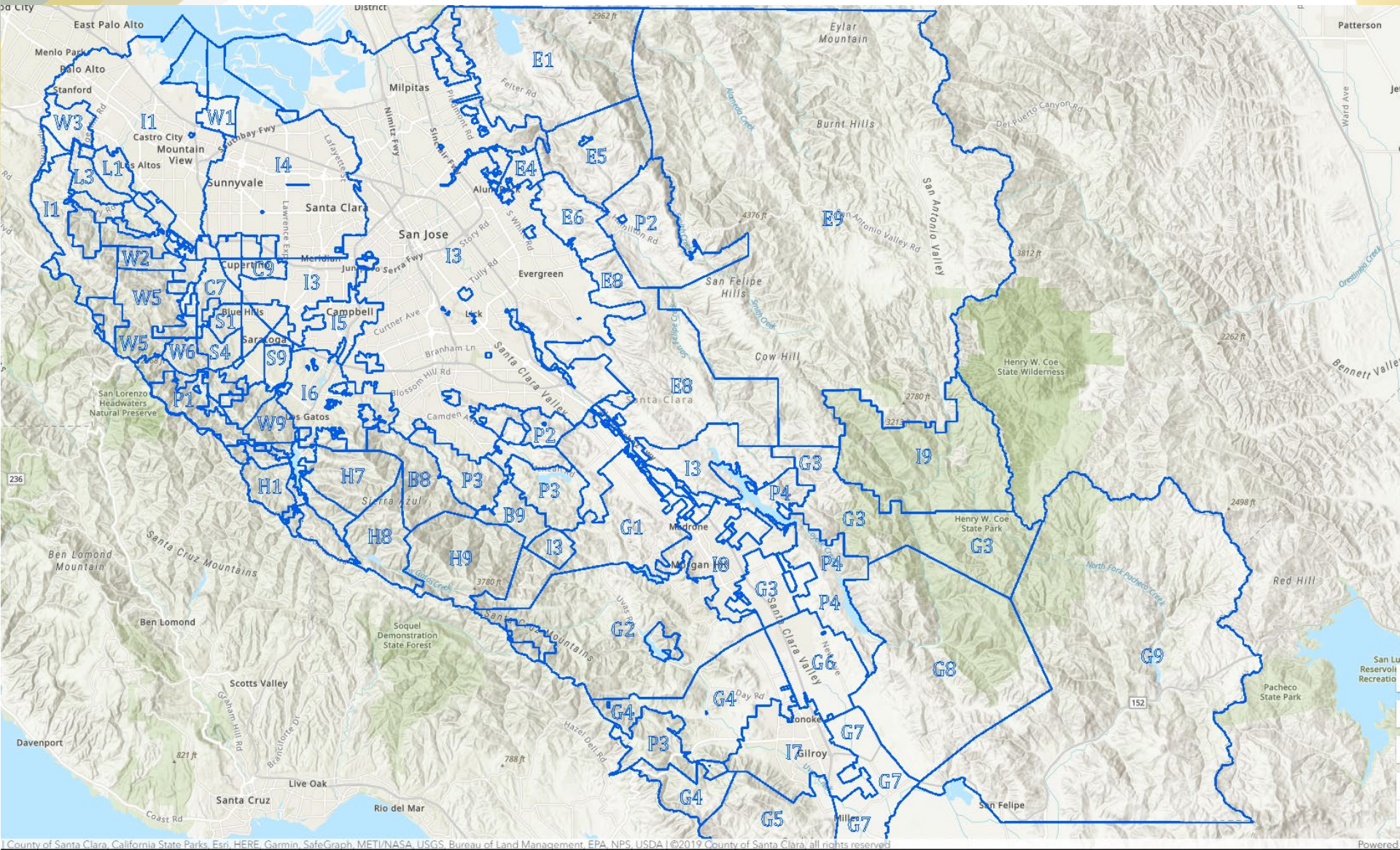

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Crime Rates and UCR Stats

The following pages contain Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) statistics related to crimes reported to the Santa Clara County Sheriff's Office. The Department of Justice (DOJ) uses data on reported homicides, rape, robberies, and aggravated assaults to calculate violent crime rates; while property crimes are derived from the number of burglaries, thefts, and vehicle thefts. The overall crime rate is the combination of violent crimes, property crimes, and incidents of arson.

Crime statistics are reported to DOJ in accordance with UCR guidelines. It is important to note that crime data from other sources may be categorized differently. The Santa Clara County Sheriff's Office provides this detailed information to give the community an overview of the types of crimes and law enforcement activity within the county. The data also includes incidents occurring within our jails, which may introduce variations in crime rates when compared to other cities and jurisdictions. For further clarity, the next page contains a list of definitions of UCR related crimes.

UCR Offense Definitions

Homicide	The willful (nonnegligent) killing of one human being by another. Deaths caused by negligence, attempts to kill, assaults to kill, suicides, and accidental deaths are excluded.
Rape	The penetration, no matter how slight, of the vagina or anus with any body part or object, or oral penetration by a sex organ of another person, without the consent of the victim.
Robbery	The taking or attempting to take anything of value from the care, custody, or control of a person or persons by force or threat of force or violence and/or by putting the victim in fear.
Aggravated Assault	An unlawful attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe or aggravated bodily injury. This type of assault usually is accompanied by the use of a weapon or by means likely to produce death or great bodily harm.
Simple Assault	Assaults and attempted assaults where no weapon was used or no serious or aggravated injury resulted to the victim. Stalking, intimidation, coercion, and hazing are included.
Burglary	The unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or a theft. Attempted forcible entry is included.
Theft	The unlawful taking, carrying, leading, or riding away of property from the possession or constructive possession of another. Attempted larcenies are included. Embezzlement, confidence games, forgery, check fraud, etc., are excluded. Grand theft is committed when the value of the property taken exceeds \$950.
Vehicle Theft	The theft or attempted theft of a motor vehicle. A motor vehicle is self-propelled and runs on land surface and not on rails. Motorboats, construction equipment, airplanes, and farming equipment are specifically excluded from this category.



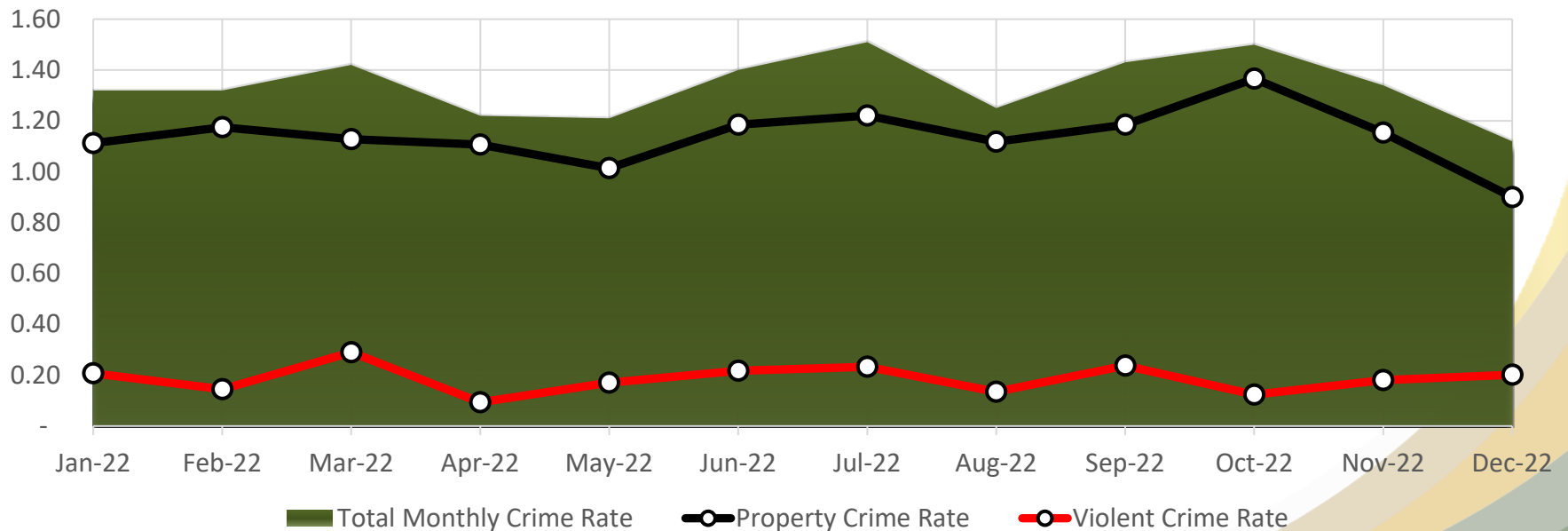

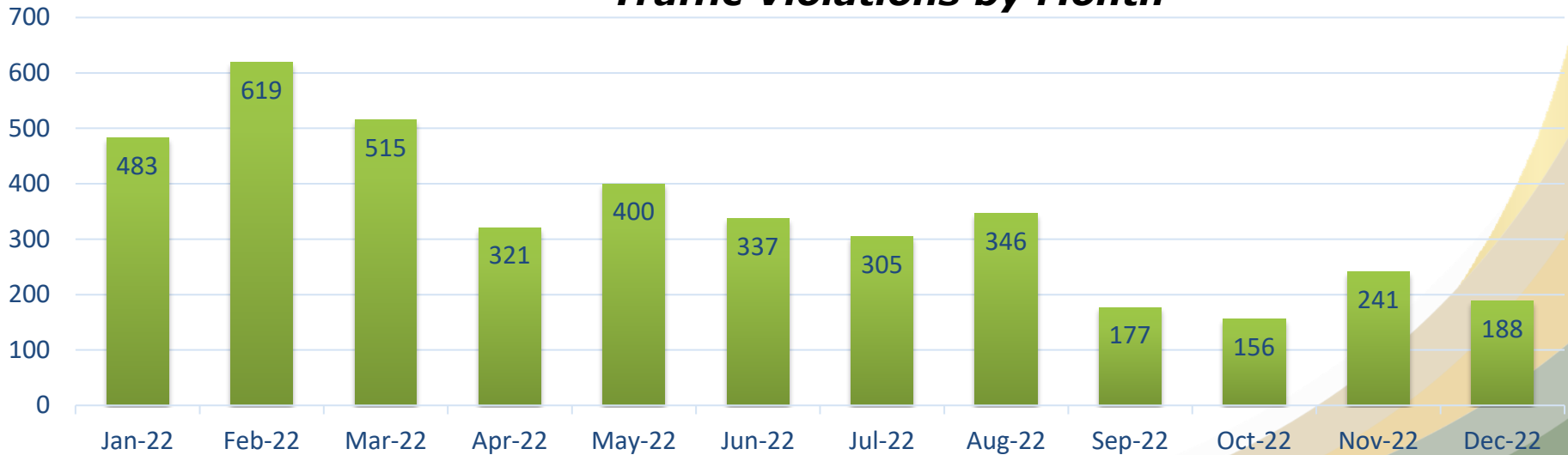

Traffic Violations by Month

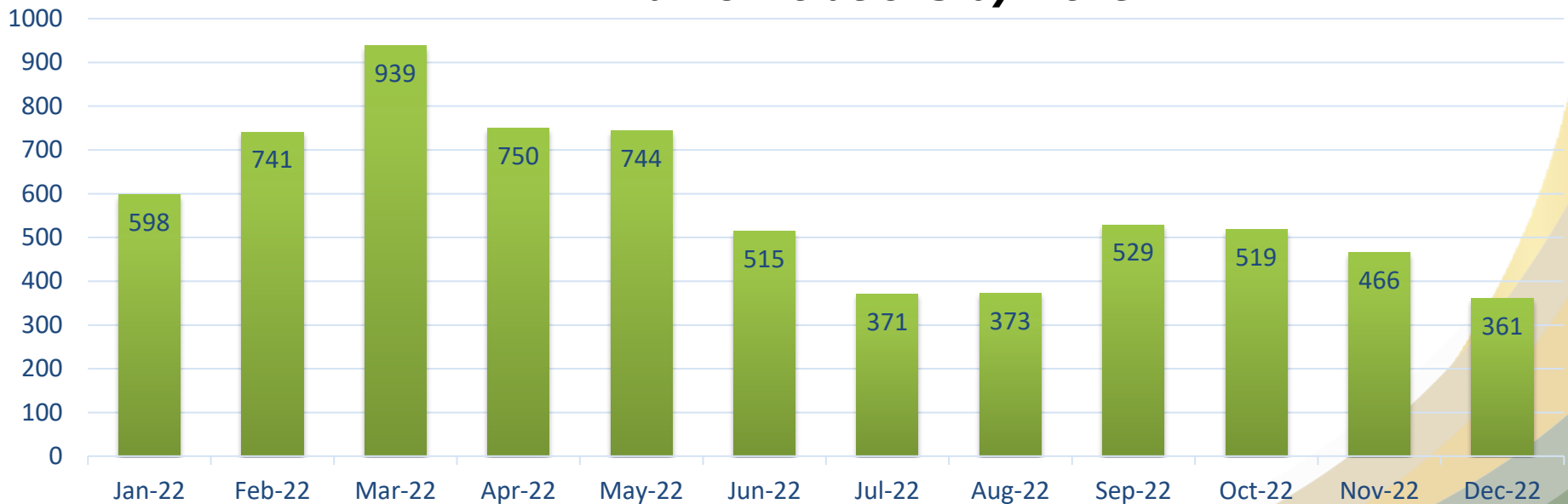

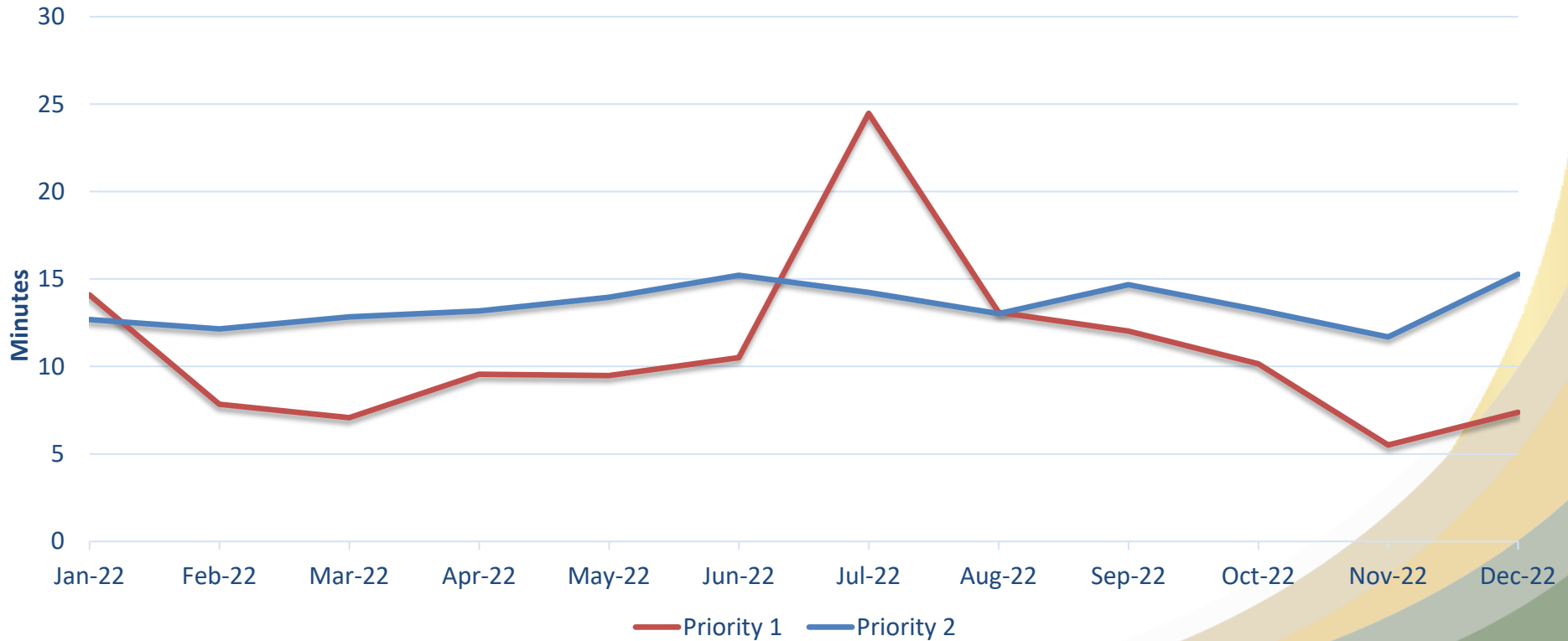
Traffic Violations by Month

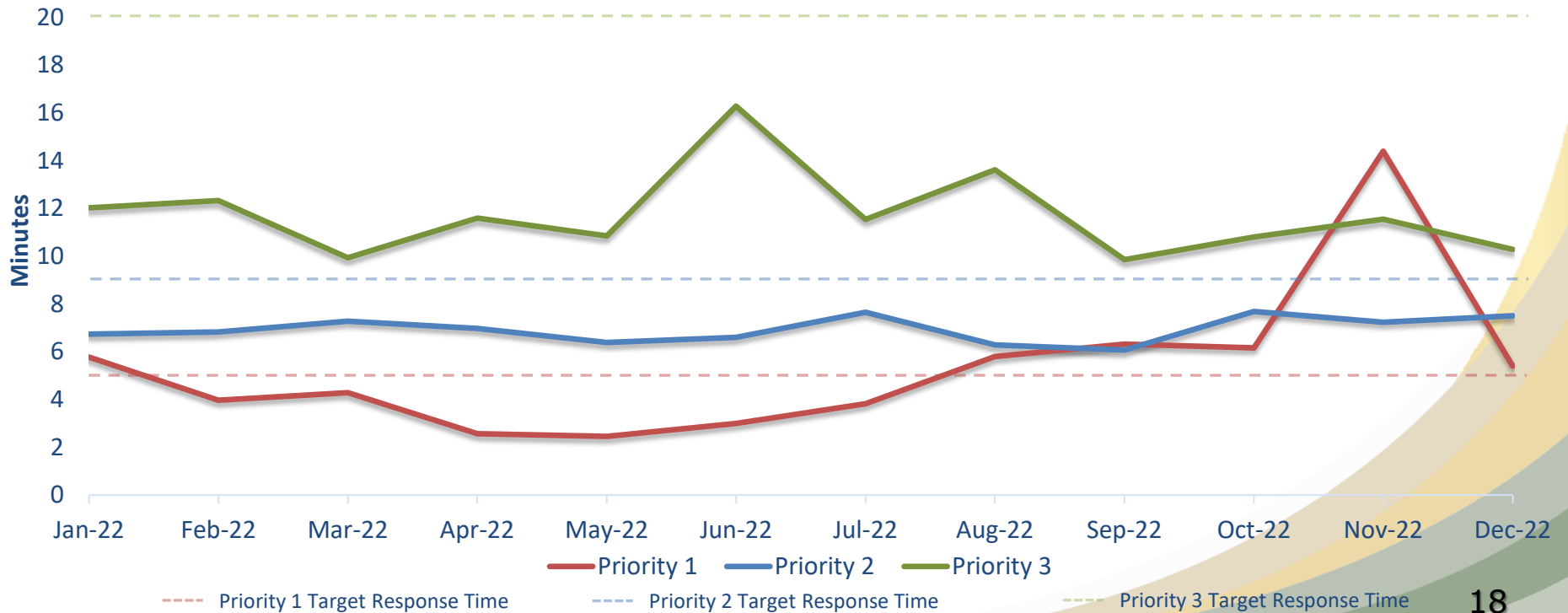

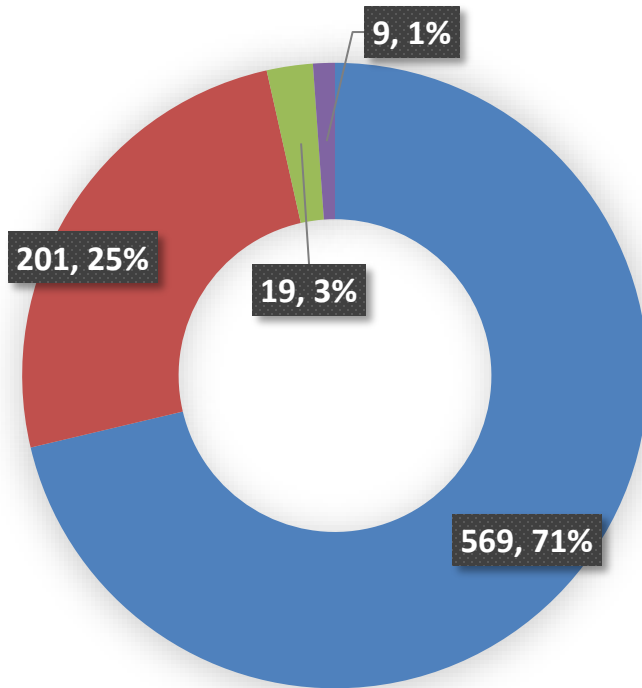

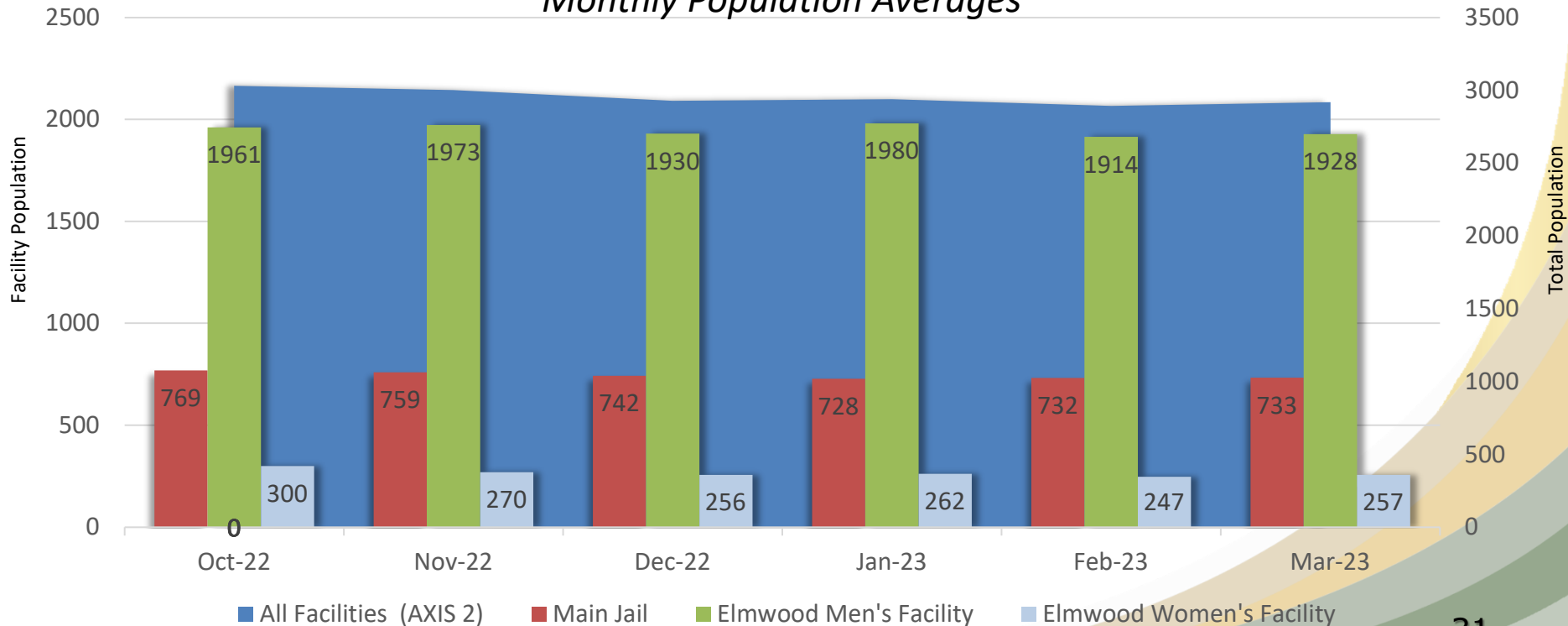

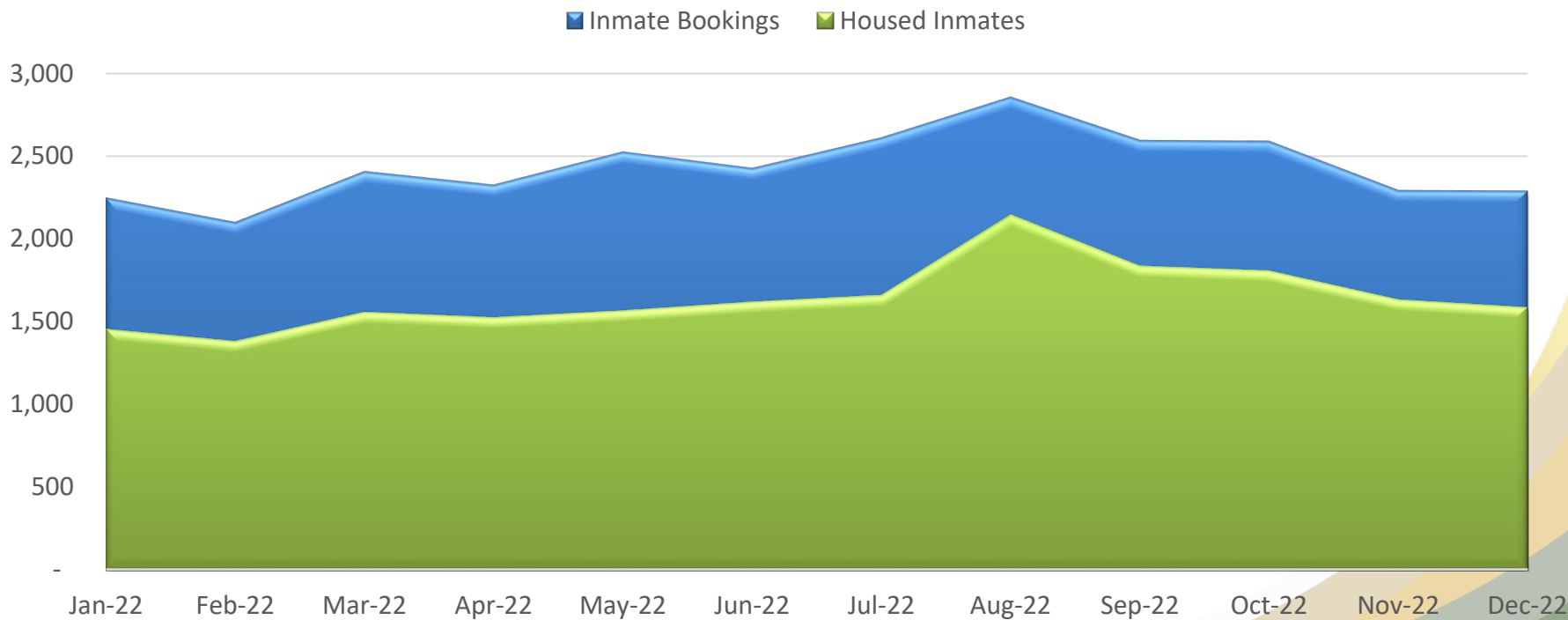

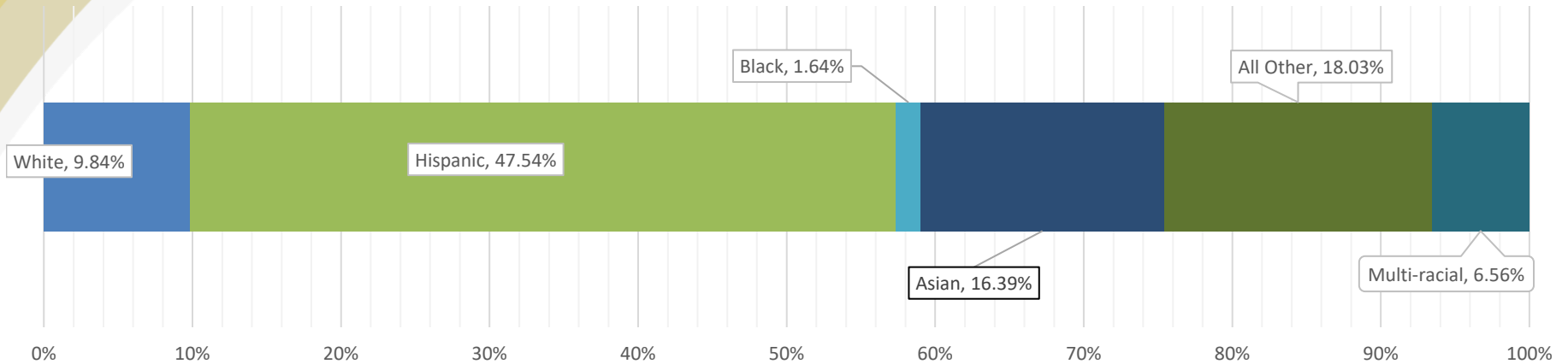

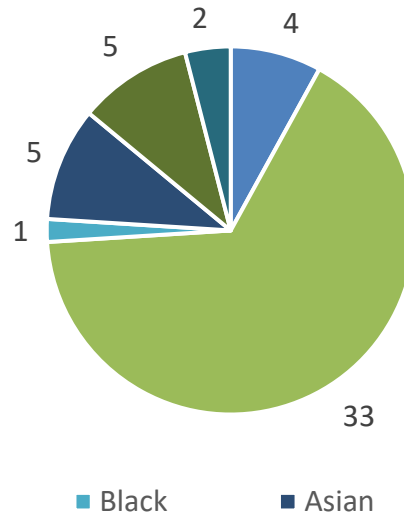
Total Agency Hiring Demographics, Rolling 12 Months



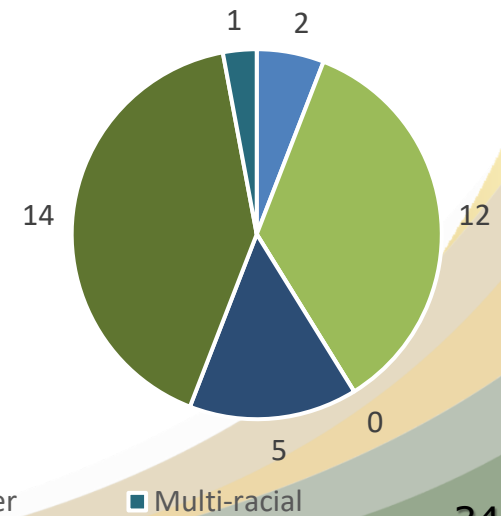
