Q: My name is Deputy Biscardi with the Santa Clara County Sheriff's Office. It's approximately 1552 hours, today's date is 12/10/2013. I'm sitting next to And how do you pronounce your last name, sir?

Q: Okay, So, I believe you were explaining to me that you were at your business which is called Roku on - at 12980 Saratoga Avenue in Saratoga, is that correct?

Q: Okay. Can you explain to me what happened today while you were in your office around 12 o'clock?

A: We were in the middle of a meeting with, uh, the people in the meeting were , he's from Dell, from Intraserve and from Roku. And, um, after about 30 minutes or maybe about an hour into our meeting, I think, um, I think that's when, uh, not so sure of things but after 12:00, we see this person walk in the door. Um, and I was under the impression that he was - he worked - I had never seen him before, so I - I thought he worked for Dell because he said - the first thing he said was, "I'm late." And he sat down. I thought he was, you know, he worked for Dell and I offered him a sandwich and he said, "Oh, thanks." And he took it and he started eating the sandwich. And, um, a few minutes after, you know, he was eating the sandwich. He was kind of laughing a little bit. Looking up on - at the, you know, board, I guess, I don't - I don't know what he was thinking. But he, ah - he put the sandwich down. He grabbed some pills, started taking them, then started calling his dad, uh, it would appear - he said he was - dialed the number and it was his dad

46 because he said, "Dad, you need - you need to come pick me up." And he was  
47 nervous. And my co-worker , uh, said to him, "Hey, you can't do that.  
48 We're in the middle of a meeting. What are you doing?" And, um - and  
49 told his father to call him on a cell phone and after - after that he started  
50 popping more pills and, uh, said, "Listen, we need to, uh" because he's  
51 trying to self-induce the first time, right next to me. And said, "You  
52 know, we need to call - you know, we got to get you help. We need to call  
53 911." And I think at that point while - while he was still, uh - I think that's  
54 when he went outside and started going to the ground and started taking more  
55 pills and then started self-inducing. And is on the phone with 911  
56 describing what was going on. He ran out the - out the, you know, door, uh,  
57 the - Brandon. And, um, while was on the phone, you know, um, I guess,  
58 uh, a couple of minutes later we hear the sirens and ran out, I guess,  
59 looking for him and then I ran out. And I could see him running across the  
60 parking lot back and forth. And - and then he must have ran on the other side  
61 of the building where the, uh, paramedics and the police and the fire trucks  
62 was. And that's all I saw, and I didn't see anything else after that.

64 Q: Okay. And - so just to make sure I've gathered this straight. You're having the  
65 meeting with the individuals that you named around - you said approximately,  
66 is it 12 o'clock you said?

68 A: It must have been. I - I - I didn't have my clock. I didn't have a watch.

70 Q: Okay. Then that's when the male walked in who you later learned his name  
71 was Brandon Marshal.

73 A: Yes, sir.

75 Q: Um, could you tell what kind of pills he was taking by looking at them?  
76

77 A: It was in a container that looked like it was from CVS Pharmacy. Um, the  
78 color of the pills -- after the fact I learned were as he tried to self-induce the  
79 vomiting, um, the pills were yellow in color because, I mean, they were  
80 crushed on the floor in the lobby -- but that's all I could tell you. I don't know  
81 what kind of pills they were.  
82

83 Q: Okay. So you only observed everything up to that point where you lost sight  
84 of him.  
85

86 A: Yeah.  
87

88 Q: After you lost sight of him you didn't see anything else?  
89

90 A: I - I didn't see anything else. I don't know what happened to him.

92 Q: Okay.

94 A: I don't know the official story.
