- Help you meet immediate needs.
- Connect you with local resources.
- Guide you through the court process.
- Aid in recovery of lost income.
- Provide one-on-one support for their identity for cash payment to cover loss of income, medical and/or burial expense, and rehabilitation costs from the State of California, Section 10949 et seq. of the Government Code entitles crime victims to such assistance if as a direct result of the crime, they suffer:
- Sustained physical or emotional injury.
- Death, regardless of the injured or deceased victim's age.
- Legally assumed or voluntarily paid medical or burial expenses of the deceased victim.

Claims must be filed with the Court Board of Control for the State of California within one year of the crime, except for certain extraordinary circumstances.
